### **NEW BUSINESS**

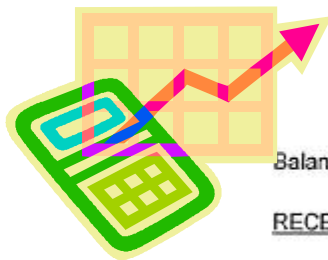
Dawn Schachinger talked about the Michigan Mixer which will be held in Flint on April 24. There will be 8 classes for attendees to choose from.

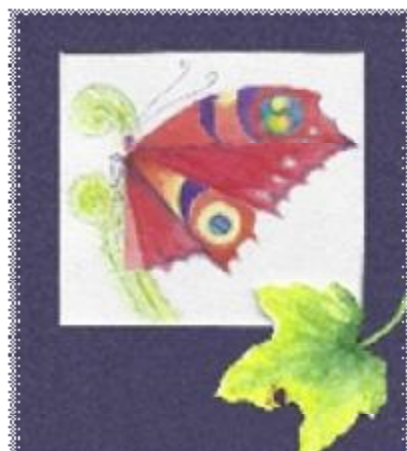
